PONIES will be less than 56 inches and horses will be 54 inches and over. The animal will be designated either a horse or pony at the beginning of the season, and must remain in that classification for the entire season. **MINIATURES** will be 38 inches & under. The animal will be designated either a horse or mini at the beginning of the season, and must remain in that classification for the entire season.

An OPEN class is open to all ages and breeds of horse, pony or mini and any age rider, with the exception being Walk Only and Walk/Trot horse/rider combinations.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Age of rider is as of January 1 of current year.

WALK ONLY and WALK/TROT

Walk Only and Walk/Trot exhibitor/horse combination shall not ride in walk/trot/canter classes during same show day (with the exception of Green Pleasure class and speed classes). Walk-Trot exhibitor/horse combination may move to Walk/Trot/Canter classes and back to Walk/Trot classes but will not be eligible for year-end awards.

Pleasure Division Walk Only and Walk/Trot exhibitor/horse combination may walk/trot/canter in their respective Speed Division.

AWARDS

Points are awarded to <u>horse/rider</u> <u>combination</u>. You must be a EUPHA member to be eligible. To be eligible for year-end class awards, must show in 4 of 6 individual classes. To be eligible for overall year-end awards must show in 4 of the 6 shows. Every show will count towards year ends and individual class awards.

Sweepstakes class(es) and Speed classes will not receive year-end class awards.

Divisions include: Walk Trot Youth, Walk Trot Adult, Youth 13 & under, Youth 14-19, Adult 20 & over.

Speed: Pony 13 & Under, Youth 13 & under, Youth 14-19 and Adult 20 & over

RULES

Classes are judged according to AQHA rules. Classes not in AQHA handbook, basic guidelines will apply.

Per <u>AQHA Rule SHW320.2</u> it is mandatory that ASTM/SEI helmets be worn properly fastened in hunter hack for all ages of riders and for all Youth riders in English and Speed classes. Helmet must be properly fitted with harness secured.
